Upcoming Temporary Unavailability of Springfield's e-Permitting System

The City of Springfield will be converting the software used for processing building permits and inspections, planning applications, engineering permits, and business licensing to the new version used by the State of Oregon starting at 5 p.m. on April 27, 2017 to 8 a.m. on May 1, 2017.

In order for the conversion to occur, the Development and Public Works Department front counter will not be able to accept permit applications, issue permits, take payments, schedule inspections or provide records on Friday, April 28th. These front counter activities will resume at 8 a.m. on Monday, May 1st.

Additionally, access to the online e-permitting system will not be available starting at 5 p.m. on April 27^t. The availability of the online system will resume at 8 a.m. on May 1st.

Background: The City of Springfield offers a multitude of services online in support of the development community and community members. Several of these services are offered through a partnership with the State of Oregon and their e-Permitting system.
