### Parkway and Roundabout Open for Traffic!

Construction on Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, the roundabout, Beltline Road and Cardinal Way is complete. Landscaping work will continue through Spring 2007. The City of Springfield sends a sincere thank you to everyone for their patience throughout this project.

### Navigating the Roundabout

The new roundabout forms the intersection of Pioneer Parkway, Harlow Road, Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Hayden Bridge Road. Wayside Lane can also be accessed from the roundabout. - Do not change lanes once in the roundabout
