The City of Springfield is offering for sale by sealed bid listed surplus vehicles and equipment. All items are used and being sold because of age or mileage. All items are being sold “as-is and where is” with no warranties written or implied.

Sealed bids will be received by the Finance Department of the City of Springfield, 225 Fifth Street, Springfield OR 97477, and Attention: Leslie Wilson, Senior Management Analyst until 2:00 PM local time, February 9, 2010. Sealed bids must be clearly marked “**2010 Surplus Property Sale**” and will be opened same day at 2:00 PM in City Hall Conference Room 204/205.

Following the opening, City will notify the winning bidder for each item informing them of the City’s intent to award. Bidders will be required to deliver payment in the form of cash or cashier’s check (no personal checks) within 2 business days after said notification. If a bidder fails to provide payment within the time period referenced herein, the City will contact other bidders beginning with the second highest bidder until the property is sold. Bidder shall arrange with City of Springfield Public Works Maintenance Division to take delivery and will be responsible for all removal and relocation costs associated with the award.

Each Bid must include the bidder’s name, address, phone and fax numbers, email address, and cell phone number if applicable. Bids must clearly identify the item number as referenced herein, the item description, and the bid amount.
